Sir,


With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the permission of the Director of Education, Delhi to your Society to open a new school from class Ist to VIII without aid in Karawal Nagar of the District East, subject to the following conditions :-


1. That the provision of DSEAR, 1973 and the rules framed thereunder shall be observed by the society.
2. That the Management of the school will fulfil all the conditions laid down under Rule 50 and will provide all the facilities given in Rule 51 of DSER, 1973 to the institution.
3. That the management of the school will get the scheme of management approved from the department immediately.
4. That only qualified and trained teachers will be appointed at prescribed Govt. scales along-with all allowances will be paid to the teaching and non-teaching staff through crossed cheque.
5. That the management of the school will not ask for grant-in-aid from the department.
6. That the school will not run for the profit of any individual association or group of persons.
7. That in case at any time the management of the school is unable to run the school, moveable and non-moveable property of the school will be transferred in the name of Director of Education, Delhi.

8. That the management of the school will apply for grant of recognition of the school under DSEA and Rules, 1973 separately and recognition will not be granted unless statutory provision of Section 4(i) (a) to (f) read with 50 and 51 are fulfilled.
9. That all the recognised classes shall be run at one place only.
10. That the management of the school will obtain land from the DDA in the name of the society through Directorate of Education, Delhi.
11. That the school shall be run under the management of Mansha Shikshan Sansthan (Registered), Delhi, and suitable funds will be made available for the construction of suitable building on the land allotted to the society, as declared as per the specifications of the department within a period of 3 years and adequate and sufficient accommodation of 12 sq.ft. per student shall be provided for class-room. The normal size of the class-room is 24'x20'. No other activities other than education shall be run.

If recognition for the existing school is not sought after fulfilling all the above conditions within a period of 3 years, this permission to run a new school shall be treated as cancelled.



Sub:- Upgradation of School from Middle to secondary level w.e.f. academic session 1988-89 (without aid).

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the Upgradation of the existing Middle School to Secondary level with effect from 1988-89 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school will meet the additional liability of secondary classes.
4. That the school shall establish and equip all the Science Labs. as per the norms of the department/ CBSE and also purchase more material worth Rs.10,000/- by April, 1988 and a list be furnished to DDE (Science) for verification.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per students may be added and more books shall be purchased for senior classes.
6. That more sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students by April, 1988 and a list of the same be furnished to E.O. for verification.

7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of section 10(1) of the Delhi School Education Act and Rules, 1973 and payment shall be made through crossed cheques.
8. That the enrolment of each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per students for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class-rooms of proper size in the school and each class-room, Science Lab. and Library rooms may be fitted with proper electrical appliances.
9. That the school shall not run unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery classes be removed from the premises of the school immediately. That the School shall obtain the fresh Health Certificate from The M.C.D.
10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
12. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 and 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
13. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately.
14. That the management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the School.
15. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the School.
16. That the school society shall obtain additional land from the DDA and will construct the building as per the specifications of the department within a period of two years.
17. That the provident fund, family pension and group insurance benefits of the employees payable to the employees of a recognised private school shall be made available to the employees of the school, these benefits shall not be less than those of the employees of the corresponding status in schools run by the


With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the appropriate authority for upgradation of your school from Secondary to Senior Secondary level (without aid) in Arts and Commerce streams with effect from the session 1993-94 subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 and Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall meet the additional liability of Senior Secondary classes.
3. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
4. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student shall be purchased and made available to the students.
5. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students.
7. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 and 51 of D.S.E.A.-1973 shall be made available to the students.
8. Proper facilities for drinking water, toilets and first aid be provided. Separate toilets for boys, girls and separate toilets for ladies and gents staff be also provided.
9. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Section 10(1) of the D.S.E.A.-1973.
10. That the school shall not run any un-recognised classes or any non-educational activities within the school premises.
11. Fresh health certificates from M.C.D. be obtained and produced to the Education Officer for verification.
12. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overpaid staff, if any, immediately.

- 13. That adequate and sufficient accommodation of 10 sq.ft. per student shall be provided for the class room. The minimum size of the class room should not be less than 300 sq.ft. (20' x 15') atleast to accommodate 30 students per class/section. The rooms should be properly cross ventilated. The rooms should not be closed from three sides.
- 14. The Managing Committee of the school shall not increase/enhance fee during the ensuing academic session without the prior approval of the Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub-section (3) of Section 17 of D.S.E.A. 1975.
- 15. That the Management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund equal to minimum three months salary of the staff in the joint name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the school.
- 16. That the school shall comply with the norms of the C.B.S.E. for affiliation fee/examination purposes.
- 17. That report about the fulfilment of the above conditions shall be sent to the Education Officer within six months.
